**RE: FEMA CE Opportunities on Risk Rating 2.0 and the National Flood Insurance Program**

The National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), through which many PIA members sell flood insurance, is administered by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). As you may recall, FEMA is updating the NFIP's risk rating process through the implementation of a methodology known as Risk Rating 2.0.
